

Dr. Andrew Greene Receives AHW Grant Award

Dr. Andrew Greene, Interim Vice Chair of Clinical and Research Affairs and Professor in the Department of Biomedical Engineering and the Dr. Robert D. and Dr. Patricia E. Kern Professor of Biotechnology and Bioengineering, has been awarded a 5-year, \$2M grant from the Advancing a Healthier Wisconsin (AHW) endowment. The overall goal of the project is to create a Clinical and Translational Biomedical Engineering Program in the new MCW/MU joint Department of Biomedical Engineering that will address critical unmet needs in healthcare through biomedical technology development. The grant will provide funds to hire three new faculty members over the next three years, who will focus on Clinical and Translational Biomedical Engineering using approaches of high value biomedical devices and/or cellular engineering and bio-manipulation.
