

Dr. Andrew Greene Receives CTSI and Cullen Foundation Grant Award

Dr. Andrew Greene, Interim Vice Chair of Clinical and Research Affairs and Professor in the Department of Biomedical Engineering and the Dr. Robert D. and Dr. Patricia E. Kern Professor of Biotechnology and Bioengineering, has received a one-year, \$50,000 grant award from the Clinical and Translational Science Institute of Southeast Wisconsin and the Steve Cullen Healthy Heart Scholar Award entitled, "Developing technologies for rapid production of individualized models of congenital cardiovascular diseases to facilitate clinical treatment." The overarching goal of the project is to provide clinicians routine access to state-of-the-art rapid prototyping of individual anatomical models that have been shown to improve patient understanding, reduce surgical operating time and minimize the risk of complications.
